Here is a list of ideas and tips on how to prepare your commercial property for a professional photo shoot. The photographer will not touch anything in the house. If you foresee that you will need to have items moved during the Photoshoot, please have that done before the photographer arrives. If this is not possible, please tell the photographer within 48 hours of the shoot so they an bring and assistant for an additional fee.

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Turn on <b>ALL interior lights</b> – even lights in furniture
cabinets.
TURN OFF ALL CEILING FANS.
Light fireplaces and candles (if applicable).
Open all blinds, shades, and curtains.
Clear all cars and vehicles from the driveway and th
street in front of the building.

	<b>De-clutter</b> as much as possible. Put away anything you
	do not want to see in the picture. It's a lot cheaper to put
	these things away before the photo shoot than to pay to
	have the photos "photoshopped".
	<b>Depersonalized</b> to a certain degree. Photos of young chil-
	dren and any potentially offensive art should be put away
	Remove any <b>seasonal/holiday decorations</b> that can
	quickly outdate your photos.
	Dust and vacuum.
	Clean all desks and conference rooms
	Clean the <b>kitchen sink</b> and put away all the dishes that
	may be in the cafe areas.
	Clear all <b>kitchen counter tops</b> and put away toasters, car
	openers, etc in cafe areas.
	Clear all bathroom counter tops and put away all per-
	sonal items.
	Hide all <b>trash cans</b> .
	Replace all burned out <b>light bulbs</b> .
	Have <b>all PC's and Monitors installed,</b> this will give your
	office a look that it is a working office.

## **Outside the Office - For external shots**

☐ Have the **lawn trimmed**. leaves raked, bushes and trees

pruned.
Clean up after any animal(s)
Put away all <b>garbage cans</b> , hoses, garden tools, etc.
If there is a <b>pool, hot tub, or spa,</b> take any security gate
down, uncover, and clean.
If there will be any twilight photos taken, <b>replace any</b>
<b>broken lighting</b> on the office, around the landscape, and
in the pool.
Be sure the <b>lights for the whole building are on</b> for the
time of the photoshoot.
Open the <b>umbrellas</b> on any patio sets.
When in season, <b>uncover grill</b> .
Remove any <b>seasonal/holiday</b> decorations.
Consider adding splashes of <b>bright colored flower</b> s to
the landscape and in pots.
Be sure there is <b>not a trash pickup or recycling day</b> dur-
ing the shoot, you do not want trash cans show up in from
of your office
Please <b>turn off all sprinkler systems</b> during the time of
the photoshoot.
